What type of foster do you want to be? Traditional Foster Adoption Ambassador

-Traditional foster homes help care for the animal until they are healthy or until they reach the adoption age. They are then returned to or adopted through the shelter.

-Adoption Ambassadors foster a pet, are required to promote the foster at HSSC events, promote the animal in their community, identify potential adopters and refer them to HSSC to complete the adoption process.

As a foster parent you will be required to keep your foster dog(s) on a leash or enclosed (within a fence adequate for the animal or a home) at all times. Foster cats must be kept indoors at all times or placed on a harness or kennel when taken outside.

As a foster parent, you may have an animal in your care for a short or extended period of time. This will frequently be determined when you receive an animal to be fostered. However, the amount of time is subject to change depending upon circumstances at the shelter. If you know that you will be on vacation during the period of time you are being asked to foster, you are obliged to inform HSSC. This will allow us to find the most suitable temporary accommodations for the animal(s).

Additionally, while you are caring for foster animals, we may call you occasionally to check on the animal's progress and address any concerns you may have.

As a foster parent, we want you to know that it is occasionally necessary to euthanize animals that have been in foster care. Although this is an option of last resort, it does occur for numerous reasons.
