



## Spay/Neuter Assistance Program (SNAP) Pricing Guide

### DOGS:

Male (neuter) \$105 - Female (spay) \$125

### CATS

Male (neuter) \$70 - Female (spay) \$80

- Health exam & spay / neuter
- Microchip w/ registration
- Distemper Combo Vaccine
- Nail Trim

Rabies Vaccine\* (Dog or Cat) \$20

*\* A current rabies vaccine is required by law for all age appropriate cats and dogs. If you have a current Rabies Certificate for your pet from a veterinarian, bring it with you and the \$20 Rabies Vaccine fee will be waived.*

#### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION you need to know about using the HSSC SNAP Program**

Use of this program is based on your need for financial assistance. You may be asked to provide a current tax return (W-2), the last two pay stubs, or proof of government assistance in order to establish your financial need.

ALL FEES MUST BE PAID IN ADVANCE. HSSC accepts cash and credit/debit cards only – NO personal checks. If you do not show up for your appointment at the scheduled time, you will forfeit the fees you paid. In the case of a shelter emergency, severe weather, or staff illness, we reserve the right to reschedule your appointment.

You MUST drop off and pick up your pet at the times scheduled. Your appointment will be cancelled if you do not drop off your pet during the allotted time. Boarding fees will be charged if you do not pick up your pet on time.

Your pet must be licensed, as required by law. HSSC will help you with this process at an additional charge if your pet is not licensed.

NO other surgical services (such as de-clawing, de-barking, ear or tail docking) will be done under the program.

Animals brought in for surgery that have fleas will be charged \$12.00 for flea treatment, plus an additional \$12.00 for every SNAP animal also on the schedule that day.

All spays/neuters will have a small tattoo placed near their incision to mark that they have been sterilized.

For follow-up preventive care or for services other than spay/neuter, please contact your regular veterinarian.

You must bring your cat or rabbit to their appointment in a carrier. Dogs must be wearing a collar and be on a leash. NO FLEXI LEASHES OR SHOCK COLLARS.

Applicants must supply all vaccination records for their pet, including licensing information, if current.

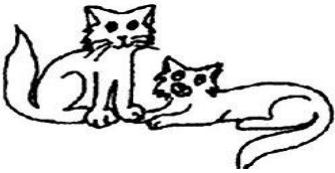
Animals deemed to be sick, have a health concern, or an endangerment to the staff and volunteers of HSSC will not be considered for surgery.

# DID YOU KNOW...

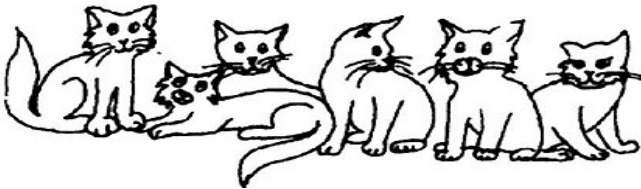
1 male cat + 1 female cat = 2107 cats in just 4 years!

If left unaltered, one male and one female cat with 2.8 surviving unaltered offspring will create:

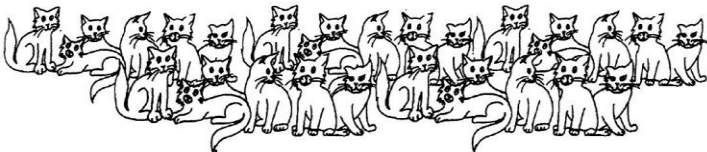
1+1 = 12 cats 1 year =



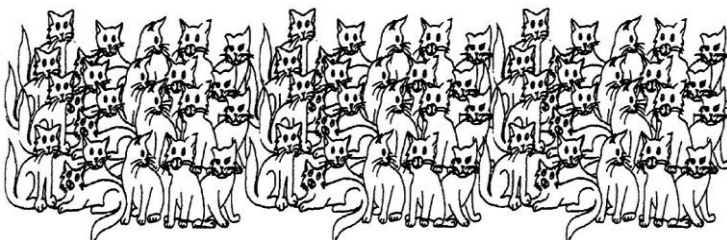
... 7 cats in 2 years =

As long as these birth rates exist, there will NEVER be enough homes for all the animals. As a result, millions of healthy, loving cats and dogs face untimely deaths as a form of pet animal population control. Others are left to fend for themselves, dumped and abandoned.

**What can YOU do to help?  
SPAY and NEUTER  
YOUR PETS!**

- Cats can start mating as early as six months of age. An unaltered male cat can father hundreds of kittens in a single a year.
- Even indoor-only house cats often find ways to get outdoors when the sexual urge hits them. Whether they disappear for good (due to panic, accidents, or enemies) or they return home, kittens are the result.
- Statistically speaking, even if a person finds good homes for a litter of kittens, some of the kittens will grow up and produce more litters.
- Spaying a female before her first heat protects her from risks of uterine, ovarian, and mammary cancers.
- Spaying also protects her from the stresses of pregnancy.
- Spaying reduces her frantic interest in the outdoors and reduces the chances that she'll wander far.
- Spaying reduces the chances she'll mark your home with urine when she's in heat.
- Unaltered cats have urges that make them irritable and anxious. They yowl or whine frequently, fight with other cats, and/or destroy objects in the house.
- Neutering a male reduces his risk from numerous health problems.
- Neutering lowers his urge to roam and to fight, and thus lowers chances of disease transmission and injury.
- Neutering also reduces his tendency to spray in the home. And neutering eliminates the powerful odor of adult male cat urine.

## Spay/Neuter Assistance Program (SNAP) Application

SNAP for House Pets— Our Humane Society Staff Veterinarian provides the SNAP services offered. The program is for pet animals only and is based on financial need. You will be asked to make an additional donation to help us keep the program running.

SNAP is NOT a feral or barn cat program. If you have feral or barn cats to be spayed or neutered, ask for a TNR Return to Field application.

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Please fill out the full application and return to the Humane Society of Sheboygan County with required financial information. Acceptable documents are: tax return (W-2), the last two pay stubs, or proof of government assistance. **Incomplete applications will be returned and will delay your acceptance into the program.** As soon as payment is complete, your pet will be scheduled for surgery.

**You MUST provide any vaccination records prior to surgery.** If your pet does not have a current rabies vaccination and is of the appropriate age, it will be given and you will be charged \$20.00. The basic fee you pay will cover spay or neuter and other services included in the program. You will be charged for additional tests and services that you request. You must license your dog per state law and license cats if it is in your jurisdiction's ordinance.
