

# Microchip Implants - Home Again Microchips



Home again microchips provide the peace of mind that you've given your pet the permanent lifetime ID he or she needs for the best chance to come home again.



## These Microchips:

- Do not hurt your pet - it gives no more discomfort than a vaccination
- Do not require surgery - a simple one time insertion with a syringe.

## How it works:

- The Humane Society of Sheboygan will microchip your pet for \$35, which includes the placement of the microchip and enrollment. You can schedule a Microchip insertion online during our monthly Vaccine Clinic. The link to schedule is <https://adoptsheboygancounty.org/learn/vaccine-clinic/>
- The microchip is inserted with a simple injection. The Home Again Microchip is designed to make sure it does not move. The Home Again microchip is a permanent pet ID.
- Enrolling owner information is what makes it possible for your pet to be positively identified, make sure to update contact information as needed.
- If your pet is taken to an animal shelter or clinic the staff will scan the microchip to read its unique ID Code
- As soon as your contact information is retrieved, you will be contacted and arrangements will be made to reunite you with your pet.

After your first year of service you will be contacted by Home Again to renew your current services. Home Again members receive 24/7 Lost Pet Specialists, Lost Pet Recovery Network, National Pet Recover Database, Travel Assistance for Lost Pets, and 24/7 Emergency Medical Hotline. **Yearly membership renewal is not required and does not affect lost/found recovery**, only the added membership services.
