NO



FIRST: Are they visibly sick, injured, or malnourished?



YES



ARE THEY OVER 6 WEEKS OLD?

If they are cold, dirty, skinny, noisy, have a sunken belly, visible bones, or pale skin they may be an orphaned kitten.

NO

Kittens under 6 weeks may have eyes that aren't fully open or are blue and ears that are small and rounded.

If kittens are less than 6 weeks old, it's best to leave them with their mom!



YES

If kittens are older than 6 weeks, it's time to get them spayed or neutered!

Kittens over 6 weeks eyes are something other than blue, their ears are large, pointy, and proportionate to their bodies.

Stray drop off and trap rental available in Admissions 10AM-4PM daily.

Strays must be from Sheboygan County.



Do you see a nest or hiding spot?

If kittens are warm, clean, plump, and quiet, mom is doing her job - she'll be back shortly! If they are in a dangerous spot, move them back to their nest or to a safe place nearby.
